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1 AN ACT supplementing and amending by decreasing the appropriations of public moneys out of
2 the Treasury in the State Fund, General Revenue, to the Department of Health and Human
3 Resources – Division of Human Services, fund 0403, fiscal year 2016, organization 0511,
4 and to the Bureau of Senior Services, fund 0420, fiscal year 2016, organization 0508, by
5 supplementing, amending and decreasing the appropriations for the fiscal year ending
6 June 30, 2016.

7 Whereas, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget Document,
8 dated January 13, 2016, which included a Statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting
9 forth therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2015, and further included the estimate of revenues
10 for the fiscal year 2016, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular appropriations for
11 the fiscal year 2016; and

12 Whereas, The Secretary of the Department of Revenue has submitted a monthly General
13 Revenue Fund Collections Report for the first six months of fiscal year 2016 as prepared by the
14 State Budget Office; and

15 Whereas, This report demonstrates that the State of West Virginia has experienced a
16 revenue shortfall of approximately \$158 million for the first six months of fiscal year 2016, as
17 compared to the monthly revenue estimates for the first six months of the fiscal year 2016; and

18 Whereas, Current economic and fiscal trends will result in projected year-end revenue
19 deficits, including potential significant shortfalls in Severance Tax, and shortfalls in Personal
20 Income Tax and Consumers Sales and Use Tax; and

21 Whereas, Projected year-end revenue surpluses in various other General Revenue
22 sources will only offset a small portion of these deficits; and

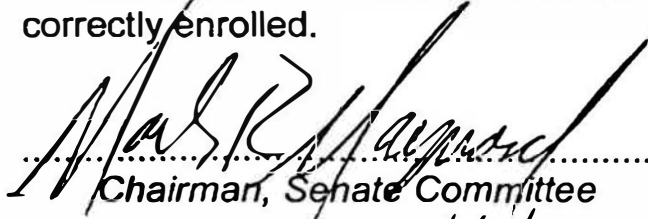
23 Whereas, The total projected year-end revenue deficit for the General Revenue Fund is
24 estimated at \$354 million; and

25 Whereas, On October 22, 2015, the Governor issued Executive Order 7-15 which directed
26 a spending reduction for General Revenue appropriations for fiscal year 2016 totaling
27 \$93,379,526; and
