1 A BILL to amend and reenact §20-2-19 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to marking traps with a Division of Natural Resources identification number.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §20-2-19 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and
2 reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.

§20-2-19. Marking of traps.

1 All traps used for taking game or fur-bearing animals shall be marked with a durable plate
2 or tag, attached to the snare, trap or trap chain, bearing: (1) The name and address of the owner
3 of the trap; or (2) the trapper's Division of Natural Resources identification number.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources identification tag to be used to identify a trap.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
