- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 Fees for Physical Therapist and Physical Therapist Assistant.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Physical Therapy.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on April 22, 2016, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section six, article twenty, chapter thirty of this code, relating to the Board of Physical
- 3 Therapy (Fees for Physical Therapist and Physical Therapist Assistant, 16 CSR 04), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Fees for Physical Therapist and Physical Therapist Assistant.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
