1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule
 3 relating to Operational Standards for Schools of Barbering, Cosmetology, Hair Styling,
 4 Nail Technology and Aesthetics.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
 2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 24, 2016, authorized under the
 2 authority of section six, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
 3 Barbers and Cosmetologists to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review
 4 Committee and refiled in the State Register on January 26, 2017, relating to the Board of Barbers
 5 and Cosmetologists (Operational Standards for Schools of Barbering, Cosmetology, Hair Styling,
 6 Nail Technology and Aesthetics, 3 CSR 04), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Operational Standards for Schools of Barbering, Cosmetology, Hair Styling, Nail Technology and Aesthetics.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
