1	A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2	to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative
3	rule relating to Clinical Laboratory Technician and Technologist Licensure and
4	Certification.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted

2 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the authority of section ten, article five-j, chapter sixteen of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 6, 2016, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources (Clinical Laboratory Technician and Technologist Licensure and Certification, 64 CSR 57), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Clinical Laboratory Technician and Technologist Licensure and Certification.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
