1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Board of Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
3 Continuing Education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Optometry.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the
2 authority of section six, article eight, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of Optometry
3 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State
4 Register on October 3, 2016, relating to the Board of Optometry (Continuing Education, [14 CSR](#)
5 [10](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Continuing Education.
