1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating  
 3 to Osteopathic Physician Assistants.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted  
 2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS  
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Osteopathic Medicine.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 29, 2016, authorized under the  
 2 authority of section three, article three-e, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of  
 3 Osteopathic Medicine to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee  
 4 and refiled in the State Register on September 29, 2016, relating to the Board of Osteopathic  
 5 Medicine (Osteopathic Physician Assistants, [24 CSR 02](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to. authorize the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Osteopathic Physician Assistants.
