INTRODUCED H.B. 2017R2398

1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

2 designated §30-1-21, relating to reciprocity of occupational licenses with other states.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new

2 section, designated §30-1-21, to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL STATE BOARDS OF EXAMINATION OR REGISTRATION REFERRED TO IN CHAPTER.

#### §30-1-21. Reciprocity.

- 1 (a) Notwithstanding the licensure requirements of each profession in this chapter, a
- 2 person, who has obtained and maintained for three years an unrestricted license granted by
- 3 another state to practice a profession licensed under this chapter and has not received a
- 4 <u>complaint for the three most recent years, meets the educational and experience requirements to</u>
- 5 apply for licensure.
- 6 (b) The board may perform a criminal background and interview the applicant to determine
- 7 his or her character.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit a licensed professional in another state to apply for licensure in West Virginia, if certain conditions are met.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
