INTRODUCED H.B.

- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §11-21-4g, relating to eliminating the tax brackets under the personal income
- 3 tax and changing the rate of the tax.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
section, designated §11-21-4g to read as follows:

ARTICLE 21. PERSONAL INCOME TAX.

§11-21-4g. Rate of tax -- Taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2018.

- 1 (a) Rate of tax on individuals, married individuals filing separate returns, individuals filing
- 2 joint returns, heads of households, estates and trusts. -- The tax imposed by section three of this
- 3 article on the West Virginia taxable income of every individual; every individual who is a head of
- 4 <u>a household in the determination of his or her federal income tax for the taxable year; every</u>
- 5 husband and wife who file a joint return under this article; married individuals filing separate
- 6 returns; every individual who is entitled to file his or her federal income tax return for the taxable
- 7 year as a surviving spouse; and every estate and trust, is five and one-tenth percent of the taxable
- 8 income.
- 9 (b) Applicability of this section. -- The provisions of this section are applicable in
- 10 determining the rate of tax imposed by this article for all taxable years beginning after December
- 11 <u>31, 2017, and are in lieu of the rates of tax specified in section four-e of this article.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to eliminate the tax brackets under the personal income tax and change the rate of the tax.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
