1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the State Fire Marshal to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the
3 regulation of fireworks and related explosive materials.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND
PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-6-1. State Fire Marshal.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the
2 authority of section eight, article three-e, chapter twenty-nine of this code, modified by the State
3 Fire Marshal to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled
4 in the State Register on December 21, 2016, relating to the State Fire Marshal (Regulation of
5 Fireworks and Related Explosive Materials, [103 CSR 04](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Fire Marshal to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Regulation of Fireworks and Related Explosive Materials.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
