### **Senate Bill 116**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to  
3 promulgate a legislative rule relating to law-enforcement training and certification  
4 standards.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted  
2 to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND  
PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-6-1. Law-enforcement training and certification standards.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the  
2 authority of section three, article twenty-nine, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the  
3 Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to meet the objections of the  
4 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 20,  
5 2016, relating to the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction (Law  
6 Enforcement Training and Certification Standards, [149 CSR 02](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Law-Enforcement Training and Certification Standards.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
