## Senate Bill 126

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Health Care Authority to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 certificate of need.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

# ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-5-1. Health Care Authority.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 23, 2016, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section four, article two-d, chapter sixteen of this code, modified by the Health Care
- 3 Authority to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in
- 4 the State Register on December 19, 2016, relating to the Health Care Authority (Certificate of
- 5 Need, 65 CSR 32), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Health Care Authority to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Certificate of Need.
