- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate
- a legislative rule relating to limited prescriptive authority for nurses in advanced practice.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 2, 2016, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section four, article seven, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
- 3 Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-
- 4 making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 1, 2016, relating to the
- 5 Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses (Limited Prescriptive Authority for Nurses
- 6 in Advanced Practice, 19 CSR 08), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Limited Prescriptive Authority for Nurses in Advanced Practice.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
