- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- to authorizing the Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to promulgate a
- 3 legislative rule relating to licensure of speech-pathology and audiology.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 22, 2016, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section seven, article thirty-two, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the Board of
- 3 Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making
- 4 Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on January 23, 2017, relating to the Board of
- 5 Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology (Licensure of Speech-Pathology and Audiology, 29
- 6 CSR 01), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensure of Speech-Pathology and Audiology.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
