1 A BILL to repeal §16-25-1, §16-25-2, §16-25-3 and §16-25-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
2 as amended, relating to the detection of tuberculosis, high blood pressure and diabetes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§1. Repeal of article concerning detection of tuberculosis, high blood pressure and diabetes.

1 That §16-25-1, §16-25-2, §16-25-3 and §16-25-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
2 amended, are hereby repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal article 25 of chapter 16.

This bill was recommended for passage during the 2017 Regular Session of the Legislature by the Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Resources Accountability.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
