### **Senate Bill 411**

1 A BILL to repeal §21-5-7 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to a prime  
2 contractor's responsibility for wages and benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5. WAGE PAYMENT AND COLLECTION.**

**§1. Repeal of section relating to a prime contractor's responsibility for wages and benefits.**

1 §21-5-7 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, is hereby repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal Code, §21-5-7 requiring a prime contractor to be responsible for wages and benefits.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
