- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
- 2 designated §64-12-1, relating to repealing a Division of Natural Resources' legislative rule
- 3 relating to the Litter Control Grant Program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new
- 2 article, designated §64-12-1, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 12. REPEAL OF UNAUTHORIZED AND OBSOLETE LEGISLATIVE RULES BY BUREAU OF COMMERCE.

§64-12-1. Division of Natural Resources.

- 1 The legislative rule effective on April 14, 2000, authorized under the authority of section
- 2 twenty-five, article seven, chapter twenty of this code, relating to the Division of Natural Resources
- 3 (Litter Control Grant Program, 58 CSR 6), is repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal the Division of Natural Resources' legislative rule relating to the Litter Control Grant Program.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
