## **Senate Bill 96**

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule
- 3 relating to licensing schools of barbering, cosmetology, nail technology and aesthetics.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

- 1 That §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
- 2 to read as follows:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 19, 2016, authorized under the
- 2 authority of section six, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty of this code, relating to the Board of
- 3 Barbers and Cosmetologists (Licensing Schools of Barbering, Cosmetology, Nail Technology and
- 4 Aesthetics, 3 CSR 03), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensing Schools of Barbering, Cosmetology, Nail Technology and Aesthetics.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
