AN ACT to amend and reenact §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to awarding of matching grants for local litter control programs; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to alternative emission limitations during startup, shutdown and maintenance operations: authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to permits for construction, modification, relocation and operation of stationary sources of air pollutants, notification requirements, administrative updates, temporary permits, general permits, permission to commence construction and procedures for evaluation; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to permits for construction and major modification of major stationary sources for the prevention of significant deterioration of air quality; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to standards of performance for new stationary sources; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the control of air pollution from hazardous waste treatment, storage and disposal facilities; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to emission standards for hazardous air pollutants; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to ambient air quality standards; and authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to voluntary remediation and redevelopment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.

- (a) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 25, 2016, authorized under the authority of section three, article fifteen-a, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection (awarding of matching grants for local litter control programs, 33 CSR 41), is authorized.
- (b) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the authority of section four, article five, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection (alternative emission limitations during startup, shutdown and maintenance operations, 45 CSR 01), is authorized.
- (c) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the authority of section eleven, article five, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection (permits for construction, modification, relocation and operation of stationary sources of air pollutants, notification requirements, administrative updates, temporary permits, general permits, permission to commence construction and procedures for evaluation, 45 CSR 13), is authorized.
- (d) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the authority of section four, article five, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection (permits for construction and major modification of major stationary sources for the prevention of significant deterioration of air quality, 45 CSR 14), is authorized.
- (e) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the authority of section four, article five, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection (standards of performance for new stationary sources, 45 CSR 16), is authorized.

- (h) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 26, 2016, authorized under the authority of section four, article five, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection (ambient air quality standards, 45 CSR 08), is authorized.
- (i) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 25, 2016, authorized under the authority of section three, article twenty-two, chapter twenty-two of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection (voluntary remediation and redevelopment, 60 CSR 03), is authorized.
