House Bill 4232

A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Board of Examiners on Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to policies, standards and criteria for the evaluation and accreditation of colleges, departments or schools of nursing.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Examiners of Registered Professional Nurses.

1 The legislative rule passed on April 10, 2009, authorized under the authority of §30-7-4 of
2 this code, relating to the Board of Examiners of Registered Professional Nurses (Policies,
3 Standards and Criteria for the Evaluation and Accreditation of Colleges, Departments or Schools
4 of Nursing, 19 CSR 1), is authorized with the following amendments:

5 On page three, by striking subdivision 4.1.b. and its paragraphs in its entirety and
6 renumbering the remaining subdivisions accordingly;

7 On page six, by striking section 8.3. in its entirety and then renumbering remaining
8 sections accordingly; and

9 On page nine, by striking section 13.3 in its entirety and then renumbering the remaining
10 sections accordingly.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to eliminate certain requirements for departments or schools of nursing.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
