1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article, 2 designated §21-1E-1, §21-1E-2, §21-1E-3 and §21-1E-4; and to amend said code by adding thereto a new article designated §30-1E-1, §30-1E-2, §30-1E-3 and §30-1E-4, all 3 4 relating to requiring standards and procedures for recognizing career technical training 5 acquired in public schools, apprenticeships and training programs toward occupational 6 certification and/or licensure; requiring Division of Labor and occupational and licensing 7 board rules; establishing purpose and intent; providing definitions; and establishing 8 applicable date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

CHAPTER 21. LABOR

ARTICLE 1E. CAREER TRAINING EDUCATION AND APPRENTICESHIPS.

§21-1E-1. Declaration of purpose.

- 1 The provisions of this article are intended to facilitate certification and/or licensure for 2 workers who acquire training via career technical education provided by West Virginia public 3 schools or an employer-sponsored apprenticeship and employer-sponsored training programs. §21-1E-2. Definitions. 1 As used in this article and the legislative rules promulgated pursuant to this article: 2 "Apprentice" means someone working in an occupation under the supervision and control 3 of at least one person who holds a certificate of competency and qualification in that occupation. 4 "Apprenticeship program" means a program offered by an employer to provide supervised 5 on-the-job training to employees approved by the United States Department of Labor. 6 "Employer sponsored training program" means a program approved in accordance with a 7 rule promulgated by the commissioner of labor.
- 8 <u>"License" means a valid and current license issued by the Commissioner of Labor in</u>
- 9 accordance with the provisions of this article.

- 10 <u>"Career technical education" means programs of study, clusters, and pathways approved</u>
- 11 by the West Virginia Board of Education pursuant to state board policy.

§21-1E-3. Recognition of training and apprenticeships.

- 1 Beginning July 1, 2019, applicants for certification or licensure shall be permitted to apply
- 2 training hours earned via career technical education provided by West Virginia public schools or
- 3 an employer-sponsored apprenticeship or employer-sponsored training program towards the
- 4 requirements for certification and/or licensure in the same occupation in accordance with the
- 5 standards and procedures authorized in accordance with this article.

§21-1E-4. Career and technical education information for high school students.

- 1 (a) The Division of Labor shall coordinate with the State Board of Education and the
- 2 Commerce Department to create a list of existing apprenticeships throughout the state, as well
- 3 as a list of certifications and other credentials that reflect current workforce needs, in order to
- 4 educate and prepare high school students regarding career and technical education (CTE)
- 5 opportunities and careers following graduation.
- 6 (b) Each county school district shall annually provide each student, beginning in the ninth
- 7 grade, with the following information:
- 8 (1) Career and technical education programs within the district and adjoining districts; and
- 9 (2) The EDGE program, established by §18-3-1 et seq. of this code, which provides the
- 10 opportunity for the student to obtain dual credits that count toward the high school graduation
- 11 requirements, as well as to count toward the student's achievement of a certificate or Associate
- 12 Degree.
- 13 (3) A list of apprenticeships created pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.
- 14 (4) A list of certificates and credentials created pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.
- 15 (5) Details regarding enlistment and opportunities within the armed forces, including local
- 16 <u>recruiter contact information.</u>

§21-1E-5. Rule-making authority.

1 The Commissioner of Labor shall propose rules for legislative approval, in accordance

2 with the provisions of §29A-3-1 et seq. of this code, for the implementation and enforcement of

- 3 the provisions of this article. The rules shall provide at least the following:
- 4 (1) Standards and procedures for recognizing training hours acquired career technical
- 5 education provided by West Virginia public schools and applying those hours to requirements for
- 6 <u>testing and/or certification and/or licensure.</u>
- 7 (2) Standards and procedures for recognizing training hours acquired through employer-

8 sponsored apprenticeship and employer-sponsored training programs applying those hours to

- 9 requirements for testing and/or certification and/or licensure.
- 10 (3) After conferring with the State Board of Education, guidelines for collection and
- 11 dissemination of information collected pursuant to §21-1E-4 in a manner easily accessible to both
- 12 students and their parents.

CHAPTER 30. PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS.

- 1 The licensing boards and commissions shall propose rules for legislative approval, in
- 2 accordance with the provisions of §29A-3-1 et seq. of this code for the implementation and
- 3 <u>enforcement of the provisions of this article</u>. The rules shall provide at least the following:
- 4 (1) Standards and procedures for recognizing training hours acquired career technical
- 5 education provided by West Virginia public schools and applying those hours to requirements for
- 6 testing and/or certification and/or licensure.
- 7 (2) Standards and procedures for recognizing training hours acquired through employer-
- 8 sponsored apprenticeship and employer-sponsored training programs applying those hours to
- 9 requirements for testing and/or certification and/or licensure.
