- 2 to authorizing the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 inspection of nontraditional, domesticated animals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS

TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Commissioner of Agriculture.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 17, 2017, authorized under the authority of §19-29-4 of this code, modified by the Commissioner of Agriculture to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 29, 2017, relating to the Commissioner of Agriculture (inspection of nontraditional, domesticated animals, 61 CSR 23D), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to inspection of nontraditional, domesticated animals.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
