1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 schedule of charges for inspection services: fruit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Commissioner of Agriculture.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on December 1, 2017, authorized under the
 2 authority of §19-2-5 of this code, modified by the Commissioner of Agriculture to meet the
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
 4 December 19, 2017, relating to the Commissioner of Agriculture (schedule of charges for
 5 inspection services: fruit, [61 CSR 8B](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to schedule of charges for inspection services: fruit.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
