1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to registration  
 3 of weighing and measuring devices used by businesses in commercial transactions.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-10-1. Division of Labor.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2017, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §47-1-3 of this code, modified by the Division of Labor to meet the objections of the  
 3 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 8,  
 4 2017, relating to the Division of Labor (registration of weighing and measuring devices used by  
 5 businesses in commercial transactions, [42 CSR 36](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to registration of weighing and measuring devices used by businesses in commercial transactions.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
