Senate Bill 322

A BILL to amend and reenact §19-1-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to employees of the Commissioner of Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 1. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

§19-1-3. Employees; itemized statement of expenditures; monthly statement and payment of moneys received by commissioner.

(a) The commissioner shall organize his <u>or her</u> department and may employ <u>a general</u> <u>counsel and other</u> <u>such assistants</u>, <u>agents</u>, <u>clerks</u>, <u>stenographers</u>, <u>chemists</u>, <u>analysts</u>, <u>botanists</u>, <u>microscopists</u>, <u>institute instructors</u>, <u>pomologists</u>, <u>entomologists</u>, <u>veterinarians</u>, <u>and such other</u> <u>employees</u> <u>such legal</u>, <u>business</u>, <u>science professionals</u>, <u>para-professionals</u>, <u>technical experts</u>, <u>and support staff</u> as may be necessary <u>in the performance of to perform</u> the duties of <u>his the</u> office and <u>shall</u> fix their compensation, and may require them to give bond for the faithful performance of their duties.

(b) It shall be the duty of the commissioner to certify to the <u>State</u> Auditor, of this <u>State</u> from time to time, an itemized account of all expenditures made by him <u>or her</u> for clerk hire and other purposes, whereupon the Auditor shall draw his <u>or her</u> warrant on the <u>State</u> Treasurer of the <u>State</u> for the payment thereof out of the funds appropriated by the Legislature for that purpose, but in no case to exceed such appropriation.

(c) The commissioner shall, within 10 days after the expiration of each month, submit to the Auditor and Treasurer an itemized statement of all moneys received by him during that month, and at the same time pay such money into the <u>State</u> Treasury. of the State

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture to employ a general counsel and any other such personnel necessary to perform the duties of the office.
