AN ACT to amend and reenact §61-3-11 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 to the crime of burglary; eliminating the offense of daytime burglary; making breaking and
 entering or entering without breaking into a dwelling or outbuilding thereof a felony
 regardless of time of day; and establishing the criminal penalty for burglary.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY.

§61-3-11. Burglary; entry of dwelling or outhouse; penalties.

(a) Any person who breaks and enters, or enters without breaking, a dwelling house or
outbuilding adjoining a dwelling with the intent to commit a violation of the criminal laws of this
state is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be imprisoned in a state correctional
facility for not less than one nor more than 15 years.

5 (b) The term "dwelling house", as used in §61-3-11(a) of this code, includes, but is not 6 limited to, a mobile home, house trailer, modular home, factory-built home, or self-propelled motor 7 home, used as a dwelling regularly or only from time to time, or any other nonmotorized vehicle 8 primarily designed for human habitation and occupancy and used as a dwelling regularly or only 9 from time to time.
