### **Senate Bill 561**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §18-5-12 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to increasing the minimum contract price that requires the execution of a bond with respect  
3 to the building or repairing of school property.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5. COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.**

**§18-5-12. Bond of contractors.**

1 Boards shall require all persons contracting for the building or repairing of school property,  
2 where the contract exceeds ~~\$100~~ \$15,000 to execute a bond, with approved security, in the  
3 amount of the contract price.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the minimum contract price that requires the execution of a bond with respect to the building or repairing of school property.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
