1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to centralized
3 prescription processing.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2017, authorized under the
2 authority of §30-5-7 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of the
3 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December 18,
4 2017, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (centralized prescription processing, [15 CSR 14](#)), is
5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to centralized prescription processing.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
