1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the State Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
 3 hazardous substance emergency response training programs.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND  
 PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-6-1. Fire Commission.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2017, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §29-3-5a of this code, modified by the State Fire Commission to meet the objections  
 3 of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December  
 4 13, 2017, relating to the State Fire Commission (hazardous substance emergency response  
 5 training programs, [87 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to hazardous substance emergency response training programs.
