**House Bill 213**

[Introduced November 18, 2019; Referred  
to the Committee on Finance]

1 A BILL supplementing, amending, decreasing, and increasing items of the existing appropriations  
2 from the State Road Fund to the Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, fund  
3 9017, fiscal year 2020, organization 0803, by supplementing and amending the  
4 appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

5 WHEREAS, West Virginia voters ratified an amendment to the constitution, Roads to  
6 Prosperity Amendment of 2017, to provide for matching available federal funds for highway and  
7 bridge construction in this state and for general highway and secondary roads and bridge  
8 construction or improvements in each of the fifty-five counties in this state, by the issuance of  
9 bonds not to exceed \$1.6 billion in the aggregate to be paid for from the State Road Fund and the  
10 collection of annual state taxes as provided by the Legislature by general law; and

11 WHEREAS, The Legislature adopted House Concurrent Resolution 104 allowing the state  
12 to sell the fiscal year 2019 and fiscal year 2020 allocations of such bonds for an additional \$600  
13 million, during the 2019 First Extraordinary Session; and

14 WHEREAS, The costs of issuance and additional debt service required for the issuance  
15 of the fiscal year 2019 and fiscal year 2020 allocations of such bonds were contemplated by the  
16 passage of Senate Bill 1006, increasing funding for the State Road Fund, during the 2017 First  
17 Extraordinary Session; and

18 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget Document,  
19 dated January 9, 2019, which included a statement of the State Road Fund setting forth therein  
20 the cash balances and investments as of July 1, 2018, and further included the estimate of  
21 revenues for the fiscal year 2019, less regular appropriations for the fiscal year 2019 and that also  
22 sets forth therein, the estimated cash balance and investments as of July 1, 2019, and further  
23 included the estimate of revenues for the fiscal year 2020, less regular appropriations for the fiscal  
24 year 2020; and

25 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature an Executive Message, dated

26 June 17, 2019, which included a fiscal year 2019 revised estimate of revenues for the State Road  
27 Fund and a statement of the State Fund, State Road Fund for the fiscal years 2019 and 2020;  
28 and

29 WHEREAS, It appears from the Statement of the State Road Fund there now remains an  
30 unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for appropriation during the fiscal  
31 year ending June 30, 2020; therefore

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, to fund 9017, fiscal  
2 year 2020, organization 0803, be supplemented and amended by decreasing an existing item of  
3 appropriation as follows:
