1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the State Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
3 payment of taxes by electronic funds transfer.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE  
LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-7-1. State Tax Department.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2018, authorized under the  
2 authority of §11-10-5t of this code, modified by the State Tax Department to meet the objections  
3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December  
4 6, 2018, relating to the State Tax Department (payment of taxes by electronic funds transfer, [110](#)  
5 [CSR 10F](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to payment of taxes by electronic funds transfer.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
