1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to rules for
 3 the substitution of biological pharmaceuticals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on November 16, 2018, authorized under
 2 the authority of §30-5-12c of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections
 3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November
 4 16, 2018, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (rules for the substitution of biological
 5 pharmaceuticals, [15 CSR 17](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to rules for the substitution of biological pharmaceuticals.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
