1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate
 3 a legislative rule relating to requirements for registration and licensure, and conduct
 4 constituting professional misconduct.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
 TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2018, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-5-7 of this code, modified by the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional
 3 Nurses to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in
 4 the State Register on November 28, 2018, relating to the Board of Examiners for Registered
 5 Professional Nurses (requirements for registration and licensure and conduct constituting
 6 professional misconduct, [19 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to requirements for registration and licensure and conduct constituting professional misconduct.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
