1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate
3 a legislative rule relating to fees for services rendered by the board and supplemental
4 renewal fee for the Center for Nursing.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Registered Professional Nurses.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2018, authorized under the
2 authority of §30-7-4 of this code, modified by the Board of Registered Professional Nurses to meet
3 the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register
4 on November 28, 2018, relating to the Board of Registered Professional Nurses (fees for services
5 rendered by the board and supplemental renewal fee for the center for nursing, [19 CSR 12](#)), is
6 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to fees for services rendered by the board and supplemental renewal fee for the center for nursing.
