1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
 2 to authorizing the Division of Natural Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
 3 rules for Cabwaylingo State Forest trail system two-year pilot project permitting ATVs and  
 4 ORVs.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-10-1. Division of Natural Resources.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2018, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §20-3-3a of this code, modified by the Division of Natural Resources to meet the  
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
 4 October 1, 2018, relating to the Division of Natural Resources (rules for Cabwaylingo State Forest  
 5 trail system two-year pilot project permitting ATVs and ORVs, [58 CSR 36](#)), is authorized.
