A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
to authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative
rule relating to medication-assisted treatment-office-based medication-assisted treatment.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-5-1. Health and Human Resources.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2018, authorized under the authority of §16-5Y-1 of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 15, 2018, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources (medication-assisted treatment-office-based medication-assisted treatment, 69 CSR 12), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to medication-assisted treatment-office-based medication-assisted treatment.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
