1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2 designated §11-5-16, relating to granting a veteran with a 100 percent service-connected
3 disability a \$10,000 exemption from the assessed value for one vehicle that is not used
4 for commercial purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. ASSESSMENT OF PERSONAL PROPERTY.

§11-5-16. Assessment of motor vehicles owned by disabled veterans.

1 Beginning July 1, 2019, a veteran with a 100 percent total and permanent service-
2 connected disability, as certified by the Director of the Department of Veterans' Affairs of West
3 Virginia, the assessor shall exempt the first \$10,000 of the assessed value of not more than one
4 vehicle owned by that veteran and not used for commercial purposes.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish the PEIA Rainy Day Fund which may be used to reduce or prevent benefit cuts or reduce premium increases.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
