1	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
2	designated §5-5-2a; to amend said code by adding thereto a new section, designated §5-
3	10-22l; to amend said code by adding thereto a new section, designated §18-7A-26w; and
4	to amend said code by adding thereto two new sections, designated $\$18A-4-2d$, and
5	§18A-4-8j, all relating to granting all public employees, all teachers, all service employees,
6	all public employee retirees, all teacher retirees and all service employee retirees a \$1,000
7	per year permanent pay increase.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

CHAPTER 5. GENERAL POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF THE GOVERNOR, SECRETARY OF STATE, AND ATTORNEY GENERAL; BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS; MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES, COMMISSIONS, OFFICES, PROGRAMS, ETC.

ARTICLE 5. SALARY INCREASE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

§5-5-2a. Granting \$1,000 annual salary increase effective July 1, 2019.

- 1 (a) Every employee on July 1, 2019, shall receive an annual salary increase of \$1,000 per
- 2 year. This increase shall be permanent.
- 3 (b) This increase is in addition to any across-the-board, cost-of-living or percentage salary
- 4 increases which may be granted in any fiscal year by the Legislature.
- 5 (c) This section shall not be construed to prohibit other pay increases based on merit,
- 6 seniority, promotion or other reason, if funds are available for the other pay increases. However,
- 7 the executive head of each spending unit shall first grant the mandated increase in compensation
- 8 in this section to all eligible employees prior to the consideration of any increases based on merit,
- 9 <u>seniority, promotion or other reason.</u>

ARTICLE 10. WEST VIRGINIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT ACT.

§5-10-221. Granting \$1,000 supplemental increase for annuitants effective July 1, 2019.

- 1 (a) Every annuitant, and beneficiaries of deceased members, on July 1, 2019, shall
- 2 receive an annual retirement increase of \$1,000 per year. This increase shall be permanent.
- 3 (b) The supplement provided by this section is subject to any applicable limitations thereon
- 4 <u>under Section 415 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.</u>

CHAPTER 18. EDUCATION.

ARTICLE 7A. STATE TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

§18-7A-26w. Granting \$1,000 supplemental increase annuitants effective July 1, 2019.

- 1 (a) Every annuitant, and beneficiaries of deceased members, on July 1, 2019, shall
- 2 receive an annual retirement increase of \$1,000 per year. This increase shall be permanent.
- 3 (b) The supplement provided by this section is subject to any applicable limitations thereon
- 4 <u>under Section 415 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.</u>

CHAPTER 18A. SCHOOL PERSONNEL.

ARTICLE 4. SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER BENEFITS.

§18A-4-2d. Granting \$1,000 annual salary increase effective July 1, 2019.

- 1 (a) Every teacher on July 1, 2019, shall receive an annual salary increase of \$1,000 per
- 2 year. This increase shall be permanent.
- 3 (b) This increase is in addition to any across-the-board, cost-of-living or percentage salary
- 4 increases which may be granted in any fiscal year by the Legislature.
- 5 (c) This section shall not be construed to prohibit other pay increases based on merit,
- 6 <u>seniority</u>, promotion or other reason, if funds are available for the other pay increases, However,
- 7 the executive head of each spending unit shall first grant the mandated increase in compensation
- 8 in this section to all eligible employees prior to the consideration of any increases based on merit,
- 9 <u>seniority, promotion or other reason.</u>

§18A-4-8j. Granting \$1,000 annual salary increase effective July 1, 2019.

1 <u>(a</u>) All school	personnel,	other than	teachers,	on July '	1, 2019,	shall receive	<u>an annual</u>
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- 2 salary increase of \$1,000 per year. This increase shall be permanent.
- 3 (b) This increase is in addition to any across-the-board, cost-of-living or percentage salary
- 4 increases which may be granted in any fiscal year by the Legislature.
- 5 (c) This section shall not be construed to prohibit other pay increases based on merit,
- 6 <u>seniority, promotion or other reason, if funds are available for the other pay increases. However,</u>
- 7 the executive head of each spending unit shall first grant the mandated increase in compensation
- 8 in this section to all eligible employees prior to the consideration of any increases based on merit,
- 9 <u>seniority, promotion or other reason.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to grant all public employees, all teachers, all service employees, all public employee retirees, all teacher retirees and all service employee retirees a \$1,000 per year permanent pay increase.
