1 A BILL to amend and reenact §62-7-10 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended; and to 2 amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section 3 designated §62-7-10a, all relating to the requiring a form of a certified commitment order 4 to the Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation; requiring a form for commitments to 5 prisons; requiring a form for commitments from magistrate or circuit courts to jails; 6 clarifying the costs of incarceration; and clarifying the method of transmittal of commitment 7 orders.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### **CHAPTER 62. CRIMINAL PROCEDURE.**

#### ARTICLE 7. EXECUTION OF SENTENCES; STAYS.

#### §62-7-10. Prison Commitment paper.

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### Circuit Judge/Magistrate

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to amend the commitment paper for convicted felons to reflect the accurate distribution of costs and to create a form order for the commitment of convicted misdemeanants to the custody of the Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
