- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- designated §60-6-2a, relating to allowing a person to manufacture a stated amount of
- 3 alcoholic liquor for personal consumption.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### **ARTICLE 6. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.**

### §60-6-2a. Manufacture of alcoholic liquor for personal consumption.

- 1 <u>A person at least 21 years of age may manufacture alcoholic liquor for personal or family</u>
- 2 <u>use. The aggregate amount of alcoholic liquor manufactured per household may not exceed 100</u>
- 3 gallons per calendar year if there are two or more persons over the age of 21 years, or 50 gallons
- 4 per calendar, if there is only one person over the age of 21 years in the household. Any alcoholic
- 5 <u>liquor manufactured under this section may not be sold or offered for sale.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit the manufacture in a limited amount of alcoholic liquor for personal use only and not for sale.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
