1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Office of Miner's Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative
 3 rule relating to substance abuse screening, standards and procedures.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-10-1. Office of Miner's Health, Safety and Training.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2019, authorized under the
 2 authority of §22A-1-6 of this code, relating to the Office of Miner's Health, Safety and Training
 3 (substance abuse screening, standards and procedures, [56 CSR 19](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miner's Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to substance abuse screening, standards and procedures.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
