- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Acupuncture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 application for waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS**

#### TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Acupuncture.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 22, 2019, authorized under the 2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, modified by the Board of Acupuncture to meet the objections
- 3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October
- 4 10, 2019, relating to the Board of Acupuncture (application for waiver of initial licensing fees for
- 5 certain individuals, 32 CSR 15), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Acupuncture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to application for waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.
