1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 2 designated §24-6-15, relating to emergency telephone systems; and requiring annual
 3 reporting by county answering points to the Public Service Commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 6. LOCAL EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM.

§24-6-15. Reporting by county answering points.

1 Each county answering point shall annually file a report with the Public Service
 2 Commission. The report shall be on a form prescribed by the commission, filed at the time
 3 prescribed by the commission and contain information required by the commission. The report
 4 shall contain data for the Public Service Commission to complete its annual filing to the Federal
 5 Communications Commission.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require county answering points operating emergency telephone systems to report information annually to the Public Service Commission.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
