- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate
- 3 a legislative rule relating to request for waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 22, 2019, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, modified by the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional
- 3 Nurses to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in
- 4 the State Register on October 7, 2019, relating to the Board of Examiners for Registered
- 5 Professional Nurses (request for waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals, 19 CSR 15),
- 6 is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to request for waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.
