1 A BILL to amend and reenact §17A-10-3c of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
 2 relating to registration fees for alternative fuel vehicles by modifying the fee for a vehicle
 3 operating a combination of electricity and petrochemical fuels.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 10. FEES FOR REGISTRATION, LICENSING, ETC.

§17A-10-3c. Additional registration fees for alternative fuel vehicles.

1 (a) The additional annual registration fee for a vehicle fueled with hydrogen or natural gas
 2 is \$200.

3 (b) The additional annual registration fee for a vehicle operating on a combination of
 4 electricity and petrochemical fuels is ~~\$100~~ \$35.

5 (c) The additional annual registration fee for a vehicle operating exclusively on electricity
 6 is \$200.

7 (d) The fees imposed by this section are in addition to any other fee set forth in this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to change the additional annual registration fee for hybrid vehicles from \$100 to \$35.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
