- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §18-2-5i, relating to authorizing the boards of education to create a dashboard
- 3 to display certain information; permitting that parents or students may access the
- 4 dashboard; permitting for rule-making authority; and establishing an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

§18-2-5i. Dashboard display of school assignments.

- 1 <u>All school boards shall develop a method of online notification for a student or parent to</u>
- 2 access the student's class schedule, upcoming due dates for homework, chapter, or other
- 3 assignments, key test dates and the material the test will cover, and general classroom
- 4 announcements. The State Board of Education may promulgate rules in accordance with §29A-
- 5 <u>3-1 et seq. of this code to establish uniformity among the various school boards in this state and</u>
- 6 to effectuate this section. This section shall take effect July 1, 2020.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize school boards to create a dashboard displaying information for parents and students.
