- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §7-14-17c of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to increasing the annual longevity-based salary increase for civil service deputy sheriffs to
- 3 \$50 per month for every year of service.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 14. CIVIL SERVICE FOR DEPUTY SHERIFFS.

§7-14-17c. Salary increment.

- 1 Every deputy sheriff with one year or more of service shall receive an annual salary
- 2 increase in the sum of \$5 \$50 per month for each year of service. Any incremental salary increase
- 3 in effect prior to the effective date of this section that is more favorable to the deputy sheriffs
- 4 entitled to such increase shall remain in full force and effect to the exclusion of the provisions of
- 5 this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the annual longevity-based salary increase for civil service deputy sheriffs from \$5 per month for every year of service to \$50 per month for every year of service.
