- 1 A BILL to repeal §5-5-4a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to eliminating  
2 a special merit-based employment system for health care professionals in state-operated  
3 health care facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5. SALARY INCREASE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.**

**§5-5-4a. Department of Health and Human Resources facility employee classifications.**

- 1 That §5-5-4a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to eliminate a special merit-based employment system for health care professionals in state-operated health care facilities.

§5-5-4a is repealed.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
