A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 designated §60-2-23, relating to providing career development; and establishing annual
 salaries for Alcohol Beverage Control Administration inspectors, enforcement agents and
 supervisors.
 Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSIONER.

§60-2-23. Career development; salaries.

- 1 (a) The commissioner shall establish within the Alcohol Beverage Control Administration
- 2 <u>a system for the career development and promotion of inspectors and enforcement agents.</u>
- 3 (b) The commissioner may propose legislative rules for legislative approval in accordance
- 4 with 29A-3-1 et seq. of this code to ensure consistency, predictability and independent review of
- 5 any system developed under the provisions of this section.
- 6 (c) The commissioner shall provide to each inspector, enforcement agent and supervisor
- 7 a written manual governing any system established under the provisions of this section and
- 8 specific procedures shall be identified for the evaluation and testing of inspectors and
- 9 <u>enforcement agents for advancement.</u>
- 10 (d) Beginning July 1, 2019, inspectors, enforcement agents and supervisors shall receive
- 11 <u>annual salaries as follows:</u>
- 12 ANNUAL SALARY SCHEDULE (BASE PAY)
- 13 SUPERVISORY AND NONSUPERVISORY RANKS
- 14 Inspector 1 \$41,296
- 15 Inspector 2 \$41,679
- 16 Inspector 3 \$42,078
- 17Enforcement Agent 1\$43,290
- 18Enforcement Agent 2\$47,591
- 19
 Enforcement Agent 3
 \$49,742

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20 Enforcement Agent, Supervisor \$56,194

- 21 Each inspector, enforcement agent and supervisor of the Alcohol Beverage Control
- 22 Administration whose salary is fixed and specified in this annual salary schedule is entitled to the
- 23 length of service increases set forth in subsection (e) of this section.
- 24 (e) Each inspector, enforcement agent and supervisor of the Alcohol Beverage Control
- 25 Administration whose salary is fixed and specified pursuant to this section shall receive an
- 26 increase in salary over that set forth in subsection (d) of this section based on length of service
- 27 with the Alcohol Beverage Control Administration, including service served before and after the
- 28 effective date of this section. At the end of two years of service with the Alcohol Beverage Control
- 29 Administration, the inspector, enforcement agent and supervisor shall receive a salary increase
- 30 of \$400 to be effective during his or her next year of service and a like increase at yearly intervals
- 31 thereafter with the increases to be cumulative.
- 32 (f) In applying the salary schedules in this section where salary increases are provided,
- 33 for length of service, inspectors, enforcement agents and supervisors of the Alcohol Beverage
- 34 Control Administration in service at the time the schedules become effective shall be given credit
- 35 for prior service and shall be paid the salaries the same length of service entitles them to receive
- 36 <u>under the provisions of this section.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a system for career development and establish a pay scale for Alcohol Beverage Control Administration inspectors, enforcement agents and supervisors.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
