1 A BILL to amend and reenact §60A-9-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to exempting a veterinarian from the requirements of controlled substance monitoring.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§60A-9-2. Establishment of program; purpose.

1 There is ~~hereby established~~ continued a West Virginia controlled substances monitoring
2 act the purpose of which is to require the recordation and retention in a single repository of
3 information regarding the prescribing, dispensing and consumption of certain controlled
4 substances. A veterinarian is exempt from the requirements of this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to is exempt a veterinarian from the requirements of controlled substance monitoring.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
